English is regularly used for communication in the workplace. This course is adapted for use with adults currently in employment in different work sectors for example, construction, food, light engineering.



Online Course

- A diagnostic test to identify learners' language needs and to ensure that the level is appropriate for different learners in the group.
- A series of sessions in General and Work-related English to help learners to improve.
- Vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation.
- Communication skills (listening/understanding, speaking, reading, writing), especially for the environment where they are working.

- A series of language activities, exercises and tasks to help learners to relate the English they are learning to.
- Understanding workplace instructions, signage, processes and day-to-day written instructions and reports.
- Practical activities in everyday life.
- Opportunities to meet new people in the local community.

Course Delivery

This 12-hour course is based on similar work done by the Belfast Unemployed Resource Centre, both face to face and online, since 2015.

- Where required, signposting to other sources of English, both locally and online, can be provided.
